GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Abstract submission is open to all registered delegates
- Abstract submission closes on 15th June 2023
- Abstracts can be submitted under 2 categories - Free Paper and e-Poster
- You may submit more than one abstract in each category. But maximum of only one free paper would be accepted per delegate for oral presentation, other submissions from same delegate will be converted to e-Poster if found suitable
- The Scientific Planning Committee will evaluate the scientific quality of the submitted abstracts based on the following criteria: novelty of the research, significance of the findings, and clarity. Authors should be particularly cognizant of the importance of setting forth the objectives and hypothesis of the study in a clear, succinct manner, and of summarizing their results
- The Conference Chair serves as the head of the scientific committee and will take the final decision on abstracts
- Acceptance or rejection of paper will be conveyed by email two weeks after the last date of submission
- If a revision is required, the revised abstract must be sent back within a week

- Please make sure that your abstract is properly structured and checked for spelling and grammar. Following all the instructions will improve the quality of your submission and can influence the scores
- Word limit of the abstract is 250 words. (Excluding title, authors, their affiliations etc.)
- The abstract font should be Times New Roman, size 12 point. The text line spacing should be '1.5 lines spaced'
- Abstract for original study should include purpose of study, methodology, summary of findings/results, conclusion and significance / contributions of study and limitations if any
- Structure of the abstract for case reports and case series should be: Introduction, Objectives, Case history , Discussion, Conclusion, References and Acknowledgement
- List a minimum of 5 key words
- Title, author's name, affiliation, address, telephone or fax number, and email address should be included
- Title should be written using 'Sentence case' and should be brief and self- explanatory

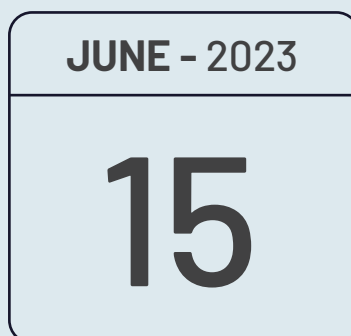
- Avoid abbreviations in the title
- Refrain from using keywords, graphs, figures, tables or references in the abstract

- Limit the use of abbreviations and acronyms in the abstract
- To ensure blinded review, no identifying features such as names of authors, collaborators, hospitals, medical colleges, clinics or places should be listed in the title or text page of the abstract. Author details and their affiliation(s) should be entered online while doing the submission
- Conflict of interest statement and declaration of conflict is mandatory
- Submitted abstracts should include non-published data
- Abstracts previously presented will not be accepted
- Use generic names of drugs or its active pharmacological content, avoiding commercial names of drugs/companies
- Abstracts may be reproduced as such, therefore onus of ensuring proper language, factual accuracy and responsibility of avoiding plagiarism lies with the authors
- Non-adherence to any guideline may result in an automatic rejection of the abstract

TOURIST SPOTS IN CALICUT



KAKKAYAM DAM

Kakkayam is a scenic damsite situated at a distance of 45 km from Calicut city. The region, best known for its wide range of plant and animal life, attracts tourists and trekkers alike. Adventure activities such as rock climbing and trekking can be carried out in Kakkayam. Located along the Western Ghats, this spot is surrounded by thick forest. Kakkayam can be reached by road from Calicut. There are frequent buses available from Calicut city bus stand also known as Mofussil Bus Stand. Travelers can hire a private taxi as well from the city to reach this spot.



PERUVANNAMUZHI DAM

Peruvannamuzhi Dam located at a distance of 43 km from Calicut city, is a picturesque damsite. It is situated in small and scenic village named Peruvannamuzhi and there are frequent bus services to the place. There are several attractions attached to the damsite which draws hundreds of tourists and travelers. This spot has an artificial lake where travelers can avail boating facilities. The sanctuary is a real delight for birdwatchers for it is home to over 90 species of birds.



URAKKUZHI WATERFALLS

Kakkayam offers challenging trekking and rock climbing experience along the Kuttiady River. The Urakkuzhi waterfalls located in the Urakkuzhi ghat area is an added attraction. This place offers breathtaking views of the valleys with numerous waterfalls.



KAPPAD

Kappad, or Kappakadavu locally, is a famous beach near Kozhikode, India, where the Portuguese explorer Vasco Da Gama landed on 20 May 1498. His voyage established the sea route from Europe to India. This established a permanent route from Europe to India. This heralded the arrival and permanent presence of various European merchant companies, leading to eventual domination and rule by the East India Company and later the period of British colonial rule.



BEYPORE

Beypore or Beypur is an ancient port town and a Municipality town in Kozhikode district in the state of Kerala, India. The place was formerly known as Vaypura / Vadaparappanad. Tipu Sultan, ruler of Mysore, named the town "Sultan Pattanam". There is a marina and a beach while Beypore port is one of the oldest ports in Kerala, which historically traded with the Middle East. Beypore is noted for building wooden ships, known as dhows or urus in the Malayalam language. These ships were usually bought by Arab merchants for trading and fishing but are now used as tourist ships.



KARYATHANPARA

Karyathanpara awaits the promise of dawn. Fresh, green and quiescent, it earnestly looks forward to its metamorphosis into a holiday hub when world-weary travellers would put up their feet and watch the Kuttiadi river quietly embracing battalions of acacia trees. Karyathanpara has better known neighbours – the Kakkayam Dam site and the Urakkuzhi waterfalls.



KOZHICKKODE THALI TEMPLE

The Kozhikkode Thali temple is an ancient one, dating back to the days of the Zamorin rule. The term Thali refers to a Shiva temple; however, the temple complex also houses a shrine to Krishna. Legend has it that Parasurama, associated with several temples in Kerala, worshipped Shiva here. Several legends associated with feudal rivalry, curses and relief from curses are associated with this temple. In its glorious days, this temple celebrated the Revathi Pattattanam festival for seven days in the Malayalam month of Tula where learning and scholarship was celebrated with feasting and awards.



PAZHASSIRAJA MUSEUM

Pazhassiraja Museum is a fine museum. All those history lovers are welcome. Visiting here takes us back in time. How we were and how we are now. It is a must-visit attraction for all tourists. Whether you are a native or not, you will enjoy coming.
